






# Company Spotlight

Sorcero is a Washington, DC-based AI company transforming how life sciences organizations extract insights from complex medical and regulatory data. Their medically-tuned AI platform accelerates evidence evaluation, improves medical affairs, and drives smarter decision-making. In 2025, Sorcero was named one of America's Most Innovative Companies by Fortune, received the Google Cloud Partner of the Year Award for Business Applications in Healthcare & Life Sciences, and in 2024 was named by Fast Company as the World's Most Innovative Company in the Small & Mighty Category. Sorcero has raised \$15.7 million in venture capital funding across three rounds, with investors including H/L Ventures, Harmonix Fund, and Leawood Venture Capital, and recently acquired Axiom Health with a \$46.5 million valuation.
